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The other was Legalism a kind of Confucianism which believed that all people were basically bad, and were required to be kept in line by strict laws and harsh punishments in order to maintain order and peace. An Religions of Ancient China of this would be the Festival of the Five Elements which honored earth, fire, metalwater, and wood which was changed to the Festival of Heaven and Earth, honoring the people's relationship with the gods.
